Partnership of Oxford Ramallah Twinning (ORT) with Oxford Ramallah Friendship

Association [ORFA]

The objectives of the Partnership Agreement are to promote the partnership relationship

between the cities of Oxford and Ramallah and their environs by:

i) fostering cooperation and support between schools and institutions of higher

education, cultural institutions, associations, clubs, societies, and informal

educational organisations.

ii) encouraging a greater understanding of each other's cultures, history, and

traditions.

iii) supporting environmental protection and sustainable development, and the local

groups and community organisations which are active in these fields.

iv) encouraging the development of the local economy, particularly through

activities which are based on sustainable development.

v) promoting human rights (as set out in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

and subsequent United Nations conventions and declarations), social inclusion and upholding the principles of dignity and respect as embodied in Oxford's

status as a city of Sanctuary.

ORT and ORFA together will encourage, promote and participate in joint events and

activities in Ramallah and in Oxford.

ORT and ORFA commit to regular coordination meetings on at least a bi-monthly basis to plan events and activities and make decisions on how they will be implemented. The

accounts of ORT and ORFA will kept together, by the same treasurer.

The Chair and Secretary of both organisations are responsible for ensuring that decisions are

in the best interests of both organisations and the functioning of this partnership

agreement.
